URBAN MASTER PLAN FOR THE 2016 OLYMPIC PARK IN RIO DE JANEIRO The **Municipality of Rio de Janeiro** in collaboration with the **Brazilian Institute of Architects-**IAB Rio de Janeiro announce an open, anonymous international competition in a single stage for the urban master plan of the Rio 2016 Olympic Park. In accordance with the UNESCO-UIA Regulations concerning international architecture and town planning competitions this initiative has been **approved by the International Union of Architects**.

The Rio 2016 Olympic Park will have an area of **1.18 million square meters and will hold 15 different types of sports** during the Rio 2016 Olympic Games. After the Olympic Games, new real-estate ventures will be built along the permanent sporting equipment and installations forming **an area that will be a benchmark in planning and sustainability of the city.**

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to multidisciplinary teams led by a townplanner-architect with previous experience in developing master plans of a similar complexity. Applications for registration will include proof of experience in 3 major projects of which 2 master plans of 250 000 m2 minimum.

REGISTRATION

Registration will be made on-line on the competition web site http://concursoparqueolimpicorio2016.iabrj.org.br/ Competition languages are **Portuguese and English**. There is no registration fee.

PRIZES

The following prizes will be awarded by the jury: 1st prize 100 000 R\$; 2nd prize 50 000 R\$; 3rd prize: 25 000 R\$

JURY

The jury will be composed of 4 foreign and 3 Brazilian members, in addition to deputy members. **Gabriel Durand-Hollis**, USA, will represent the UIA on the jury.
